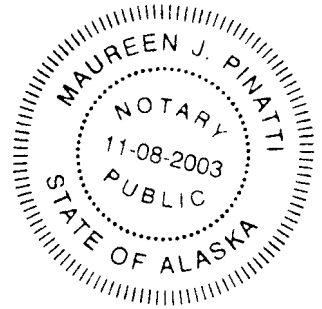

Dear Chief Justice Warren W. Matthews:

*Whereas*, you and your office operate in Federal-State jurisdictions, this Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request is pursuant to both the Federal and State FOIA's.

**Therefore**, this is a request under the Freedom of Information Act 5 USC 552(a) and ©AS 09.25.100 *et seq.* and in particular ©AS 09.25 .110 and ©AS 09.25.125.

This is my firm promise to pay fees and costs for locating, duplicating and reviewing documents for information as requested below. I am making this request in the classification of "other requestor". If costs are expected to exceed \$56.00, please send estimate of costs. If some of this request is exempt from release, please send those portions reasonable segregatable and provide me with indexing, itemization and detailed justification concerning the information, which you are not releasing.

The information will provide knowledge and understanding of the rules and regulations of the agency [court], and will assist the requestor relative to policies of the agency [court].

I understand the penalties provided in 5 USC 552(a)(1)(3) for requesting or obtaining access to documents or records under false pretenses,

1. Three certified copies of your Civil Commission empowering you for your public Office/judicial Office in the Supreme Court of the State.
2. Three certified copies of your documents of your dual citizenship (“citizen of the United States and the State”) arising under the “Constitution of the State of Alaska” Article IV Section 4.
3. Three certified copies of your license to practice law in the State arising under the “Constitution of the State of Alaska” Article IV Section 4.
4. Copies of the documents that authorize you in your public office to not have a Civil Commission to empower you in the Supreme Court.
5. Copies of the documents that authorize your Oath of Office not to comply word for word with the Oath of Office arising under the “Constitution of the State of Alaska” Article XII Section 5 that is in quotation marks, notwithstanding other areas of non-compliance of your purported Oath of Office.
6. Copies of the documents that authorize you to be an employee of the State of Alaska (employee affidavit) and a public officer of the State of Alaska at the same time.
7. Copies of the documents that authorize your employee affidavit to not have a proper jurat and comply with the laws and rules on affidavits.
8. Copies of the documents that list all of the public officers arising under the “Constitution of the State of Alaska” Article XII Section 5 of the Supreme Court; of the State and/or of Alaska and/or of the State of Alaska and/or of Territory of Alaska and/or of Alaska and/or of the District of Alaska.
9. Copies of the documents that list all of the public/judicial officers arising under the Act of Congress Statute I of the Public Statutes at Large approved on June 1, 1789 on page 23 and 24 of the Supreme Court; of State and/or of Alaska and/or of the State of

Alaska and/or of Territory of Alaska and/or of Alaska and/or of the District of Alaska.
